*The year started off as normal, but in March 2020, Covid-19 Pandemic mandated a need to create an alternate way of providing meals to the homeless and less fortunate, or else, close our doors. Jones Chapel was converted from a sit down dining room into a packing area with tables for storage of non-perishable food and other items to include in Sack Lunches.

Weekend Lunch Ministry 2020 Highlights

- 2020 Food Health Score: **100/A+ Rating** (continuing from 2019)
- Weekend Lunch Ministry Board of Directors *Met on 2 occasions prior to COVID-19. Communications continued through emails/texts and limited in person meetings.*
- Recruited 2 new Teams: (2021 Training with 2-3 Weekends Assisting)
 - 1) The Shining Star Foundation / Team Leader Shequita Mason
 - 2) Friends / Team Leader Deandra Richard & Veronica Ellington
- Purchased and Installed a New Commercial Ice Maker 300 pound capacity
- Finalized the Project for a **Weekend Lunch Awning** to be installed over the back door, along the exterior wall. This will provide both a covering for protection from

the elements as well as provide an attractive focal point for Christ Church's Weekend Lunch Food Ministry entrance.

- Kitchen **Professionally *Deep Cleaned** (*bi-annually with periodical cleaning)
- Repaired Stainless Steel Freezer (fan and heating coils)
- Installed Signage for Weekend Lunch Ministry
- Sack Lunch Pre-Packing Team Developed a Team who came one day during the week to pre pack 200 Sack Lunches for the upcoming weekend.
- Christ Church's Young Families led by Rev. Zac Neubauer, participated in serving Weekend Lunch Meals (<u>Covid-19 interrupted volunteer opportunities</u>)
- *Men & GRITS* prepared and served **Grits and Pork Patties on the 2nd Monday of each month at Daybreak**. April through December numbers slowly decreased with numbers averaging 40-60 by the end of 2020
- **Birthday Cake** baked and served a birthday sheet cake each month for those gathering at DayBreak, Macon's homeless facility.
- *Holiday Hot Meals To Go* Hot meals were prepared and served by Christ Church and volunteers on both weekends following Thanksgiving and Christmas.

During Covid-19, Grants and Other Opportunities became available. After making applications, Weekend Lunch received the following two grants to assist in feeding the homeless and marginalized population in the downtown area.

- \$255 Grant We matched that amount providing a total of \$510.00 for packing 100 Bags of non-perishable groceries. These were distributed from Jones Chapel to the hungry and homeless one Saturday during the summer.
- **\$2,980.45 Grant** Through the Middle Georgia Community Food Bank. We were able to purchase the following:
 - New Industrial Can Opener
 - 3 Food Storage Warming Bins
 - 2 Metal Shelving Units for Pantry

- 2 Igloo Drink Coolers
- Rolling Ice Chest

The following items were collected (& most distributed)

- **80 Comfort Bags** Each tote bag contained a small blanket, gloves, socks, hygiene items, snacks, etc (women's bags contained femine products).
- **89 4 Man Tents** These tents were picked up from a donor and distributed to the homeless, youth groups (including Christ Church), 2 Scout Troops, Youth Non-Profit Organization & schools.
- **960 60 Watt Energy Efficient Light Bulbs** Provided by GA Power, these were distributed to various Low Income Housing Units, Safe House, Daybreak, Appleton Ministries, and handed out at Mulberry Market's EBT Table.
- Received Various Donated Items from a Closed Down Restaurant -Glassware, Silverware, Utensil Holders, Chafing Dishes, 3 Drink Dispensers, Metal Mixing Bowls, knives, etc. Several of these items are awaiting a home.
